Wish Lists: Starting on Monday, the kids will have a chance to preview the books. They each will have a "wish list" sheet that they can fill out and bring home to you. Those lists are for your use only to help your child with their selections. The kids usually get to come to the book fair

each day of the week, depending on schedules.

Purchasing. If you choose to, you can send money to school with your child to purchase books starting Monday. Students **love** buying their own books. In addition to all the fantastic books, the Book Fair features merchandise – stuffed animals, journals, posters, folders, pencils, pens, erasers and other treasures. These items are very popular with students. If you do not want your child to purchase them, please discuss it at home. If you don't want to send cash, you can send checks (**made out to Good Shepherd**). Credit cards will be accepted as usual!

Teacher/Classroom Wish Lists: Each teacher, including the specialists and library, makes a list of the books they would like for their permanent classroom libraries. Many parents purchase books from those wish lists as a gift from their children to the teacher. When you purchase a book from their list, we give you a bookplate to place in the front of the book with your child's name. Look for the display with the teacher wish list at the book fair. If you would like help figuring out how to find a book, just ask a volunteer.

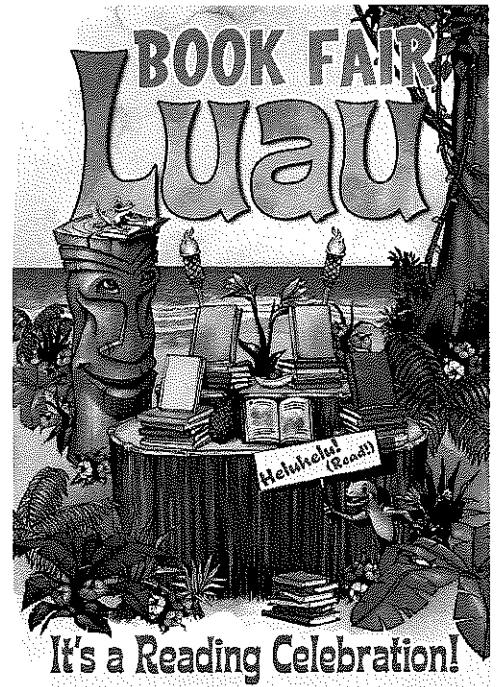
NEW THIS YEAR we are starting a Birthday Book Program which will be implemented soon in the school. The Book Fair Committee along with the Good Shepherd Staff are

very excited about this new program!! How it works is that based on donations, the Book fair committee will be selecting books from the book fair

to put in a Birthday Box. When your child celebrates his/her birthday at school he or she gets to go to Mr. Zellmer's office and pick a book out of the box. We will be participating in Scholastic's **One For Books to help supplement this program.** Each \$1 donation goes directly to purchasing those books for the Birthday Book Box. (Feel free to purchase a book(s) for the box.) In addition, Scholastic Book Fairs will match each dollar we raise with a donation of a book to 3 non-profit programs that are devoted to improving reading skills among children. These charities are: Kids In Need, Kids In Distressed Situations & Toys For Tots. Scholastic donates up to 1 MILLION Books EACH year from this program!!

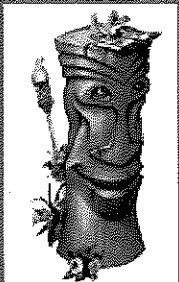

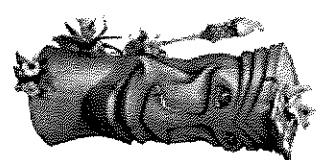
